Ahead of the official launch of the Lincoln [Knight's Trail](#) in May, our 'Knight of the Skies' is making a special visit to Witham St Hughs Academy on Thursday 20th April.

What's more, Rosie Ablewhite, the artist who has created the stunning design, is not only bringing the Knight with her, but will also be running workshops with the children to design their own flag for the shield and some fingerprint poppies too. The workshops run from 9.15 till 11am followed by a Key Stage 2 assembly at 11.25am.

A spokesman for GAME Engineering said "It is so lovely to be able to share our Knight in the Skies with the children of Witham St Hughs Academy. We love our Bomber Command themed Knight and are very pleased with the finished design. Our offices in Witham St Hugh's are on part of the old WW11 RAF Swinderby Bomb Store, and we are huge supporters of the IBCC, which is due to open on Canwick Hill later this year."

The finished Knight will also be touring other parts of the county. It will be at the Petwood Hotel on Friday 14th April, followed by a brief visit later that afternoon to East Kirkby, Lincolnshire Aviation Heritage Centre. On Sunday 23rd April it will be at the International Bomber Command Centre, and also at the Newark Air Museum on Sunday 30th April as part of the BBC's Big Day Out event. It will then be on display in the Castle Square in Lincoln from 20 May to 2 September.
